

Highlights

- New recording options for:
 - DISH Player-DVR 522 & 625 (Software Version L251)
 - DISH Player-DVR 942 (Software Version L227)
- **Maximum Events** limits the number of episodes the *My Recordings* list will store at any given time.
- **Start Early/End Late System Default** provides users with the ability to set their Start Early and End Late timer options as the system defaults.

Timer Options



Protect Event and Start Early/End Late

Maximum Recorded Events

The program's default Start Early & End Late minutes and the number of Maximum Events are visible at the bottom of the Create Timer screen.



New Choices in Timer Options

The 522, 625 & 942's latest software releases include new options for users to manage their future timers and recordings:

- Start Early/End Late System Default Option
- Maximum Events Option

These new features can be accessed by pressing **Options** within the **Create Timer** screen.



Create Timer

Start Early/End Late System Default



Users can make the **Start Early** and **End Late** minutes the default for this and all future timers by selecting the **Set as System Default** option.

If desired, users can make changes to the **Start Early** and **End Late** settings without selecting the **Set as System Default** option, making the number of minutes selected apply only to this particular timer.

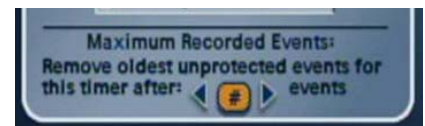
Maximum Recorded Events

This feature tells the receiver how many recent recordings of this particular event to store on the **My Recordings** list.

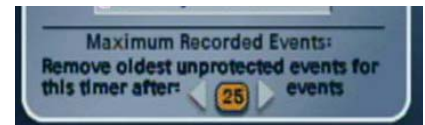
For example, if you record **Star Trek** everyday at 5pm, after a week, seven **Star Trek** episodes are available to watch. Without changing the settings of the **Star Trek** timer, and if you don't delete any recordings, **Star Trek** would eventually fill up your **My Recordings** list, and consequently delete unprotected recordings of other programs you may have wanted to watch.

Set Maximum Events

Using the remote control's arrow keys, you can choose how many recent recordings to keep: All (indicated by the # sign), 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 15, 20 or 25.

For example, if you choose "3", then the three most recent **Star Trek** recordings will remain on your **My Recordings** list. The oldest **Star Trek** recordings are erased to make room for each new **Star Trek** episode recorded. The date used to determine "oldest" is the date the program was recorded, not when it originally aired.
